



Intern Professional Standards

The interns will be held to professional standards according to industry standards and facility policies. They will also still be expected to uphold all Gwinnett County and Veterinary Science behavior expectations detailed at the beginning of the year. Most of the professional standards align with our classroom and lab expectations and we do not expect to have any issues, but we would like to emphasize some of the more stringent policies that the facilities have asked the interns to uphold:

- Cellphones may <u>not</u> be used or on at any time during internship hours.
- There may not be any social media messages or photos containing information regarding internships.
- Interns must be in professional attire, that meets facility standards.
- Interns must arrive to the facility on time and may not leave without permission from the site supervisor.
- All time sheets must be signed by a site supervisor and returned to the instructors by the students as soon as the student returns to school.
- Jewelry must be kept minimal (no dangle earrings, long necklaces, or bracelets).
- Hair must be pulled back and off the shoulders.
- Interns must have their clinical notebooks with them at all times (spiral notebook).
- All interactions with staff and patients must be professional and appropriate.
- All interns must have a professional present at all times for patient care.

If an intern acquires two violations of professional standards, then an administrative conference will be held to assess continuance in the internship. We are very proud of our students and will be acknowledging the efforts and positive behaviors during their internships, so look for those great notes of accomplishment over the course of the semester!
